Cattle Hill Wind Farm agreement finalised

AURORA Energy and Goldwind have announced that the in-principle agreement signed in June this year has become unconditional, paving the way for the construction of a 150MW wind farm at Cattle Hill in Tasmania's Central Highlands.

The partnership will enable Aurora Energy to meet its obligations under national renewable energy legislation through the purchase of Tasmanian generated renewable energy certificates produced by the wind farm.

The agreement represents a significant commitment by Aurora Energy which increases Tasmania's energy security and delivers local benefits to both its customers and the community.

The construction of the \$300 million wind farm, consisting of up to 49 turbines, is scheduled to commence in early 2018.

It is anticipated to create 150 jobs during construction and employ up to 10 permanent maintenance staff when fully operational in 2019.
